SHARPENER

RETURN ON INVESTMENT

The cost of the Sharpener is **\$1,250.00**

We have machines in use for more than 15 years but for this calculation we assume a life span of 10 years.

When used properly the wheel should be replaced after 1000 sharpenings.

It will take a body shop technician less than 2 minutes to sharpen a drill bit. For this calculation we assume the tech makes \$20.00 /hour.

Cost per sharpening:

- ¢ .45 use of the wheel
- ¢ .70 labor
- ¢ .80 amortization of machine and power.

Total: \$1.95

Average cost of a new drill bit is **\$20.00**
Most drill bits can be re-sharpened **15 times** or more.

If a shop uses **15 bits per month** it would spend:

15 x \$20.00 = \$300.00 for new bits per month
or

1x \$20.00 (for 1 new bit) + 9 x \$1.95 (for sharpening) = \$ 37.50

Using the S-115 Sharpener would save \$262 .00 per month.
Or a Return On Investment in: \$1,250.00 / \$262.00 = 4.8 months.
